
## Class of 1970 Senior Skit

Judge: Court is in session. The seniors of Meadowdale High School vs. Meadowdale High School faculty.

For the strict excuses she demands, we call Ma Akers to the stand. (Ma Akers enters)

Ma Akers: *Believe me, Judge, those kids are never really sick!* (Leper enters, sings "Leprosy!" and then Ma Akers and Leper exit.)

(BLACKOUT; group enters, four students are in cafeteria line.)

(Group then sings "Inedible-Alka Seltzer!" to the tune of "Aquarius - Let the Sun Shine In")

When the food is nearly three weeks old

And sandwiches are green with mold

And roaches crawl on countertops

And cokes that have no cups.

(Student 1)

(Student 2)

(Student 3)

(Student 3)

The food they give to us is simply inedible, (Chorus and students)
Simply inedible... inedible (piano) (all join in at end)

Judge: (after removing wig hysterically) Order! Order in the court!

Judge: Cheyenne Wally report, report,

For stealing cheese and crackers you'll be sent to jail! to jail!

(Wally enters) (Cheyenne music while Wally enters)

Wally: (frustrated, excitedly) *Let me give you an example:* 

If there was a dog in the living room, And there's another dog in the kitchen, And a dog comes into the kitchen,

Why would I take cheese and crackers?!?

Judge: I have evidence! (On this cue, Cap'n Zim Zim enters, chorus sings "Cap'n Zim Zim Song")





Zim: Cheyenne Wally fell asleep in class on March 4, 1:52, 22 seconds P.M.



They sing "Together" adapted from "Gypsy".)

Anything I wanna say, he'll say. (Jenkins) Anyone I wanna wack, he'll wack (Bostick) Anything I say to do, they'll do. (Maxwell)

Forever! Together! (All)

Though policy flaws
May irk you because
You don't like the things we may do

It's you for me And me for you In everything, whatever we do.

After Maxwell, Bostick and Jenkins sing "Together" they exit to the cheer of *I'm big, I'm bad, and I'm boss....* 

Judge: Cheery Heery come to the stand,

Your presence now we command! (Cheery Heery enters.)

You are accused of carrying a concealed weapon!

Shut up, sit down, thank you. (shows pointer) I don't have to stay here! Heery:

(As Heery exits, he sees a juror sleeping and whacks him on the head.)



Judge: Uncle Phil, Student Council is where your guilt lies,

For this mistake which you now deny.

Phil: My Student Council is really great,

As long as they can stay awake!

(BLACKOUT to Student Council scene where the group sings a parody to the tune of "Officer

Krupke". At the end of the song, **J.D.** enters.)

Dear kindly student council, We'd like to let you know Our homerooms show no interest And things are going slow.

The students hate the teachers, The teachers hate the kids, No one cares and that's the way it is.

Dear President Pammy,

What are we to do?

We only come to meetings to get out of homeroom.

So, if you've got projects you want to complete,

Don't ask the students, we're asleep!

We're asleep, we're asleep, we are all asleep.

So, don't bother us 'cause we're asleep!

J.D.: Wake up you flaky germs! God didn't put you on this earth to sleep!

You've got a lot to live, and Pepsi's got a lot to give!

Judge: The Humanities team, Harry, Marion, John and Roy could not be present because

they were locked up in their office and are sooooooo busy. However, we do have

evidence proving that they are guilty of breach of contract!

(BLACKOUT --- the team is making out contracts)

Harry: Well, we finally compiled all the projects with nudes!

Marion: *NUDES?* 

Roy: (sings Nudes, Glorious Nudes)

Nudes, Glorious Nudes Oh, what a sensation! Nudes, Glorious Nudes Sweet ornamentation.

John: But, but, but.....

All 3: Sit down, John, for God's sake, John, sit down!

John, you're a bore, we've heard this before.

SO FOR GOD'S SAKE, JOHN, SIT DOWN! (from "1776")

(chattering resumes)

Marion: No, no, no, no, NO!!! Whatever Marion wants, Marion gets,

And, gentlemen, don't you know you can't win! (from "Damn Yankees")

(Self looks down at papers) These papers are not stapled!! (She throws them high into the air.)

Judge: Cornelius Paul --- you are charged with the serious offense of contributing to the

(Jury sings "You're a Good Man, Cornelius Paul" - adapted from "You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown" -

as Mr. Trimble is ushered on stage.)

(BLACKOUT back to courtroom.)

Judge:

 $Will\ all\ the\ accused\ come\ forward.$  (As the defendants walk in, the verdict is brought in.)

The verdict please.

Jury and Seniors shout "GUILTY!"

Prather:

You broke the law, you are in jail, this was your intention.

The sentence: There will be no bail, serve lifelong detentions.....

Finale: (Song "Meadowdale Is")
